Moscow, Idaho Court Hearings to be Discontinued

Bankruptcy Court: Effective September 1, 2017, the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Idaho will no longer conduct court hearings at the Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse in Moscow, Idaho. All Bankruptcy Court hearings for cases assigned to the Court's "Central Division" (Clearwater, Idaho, Latah, Lewis and Nez Perce Counties) will be held at the U.S. Courthouse located at 6450 N. Mineral Drive, in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

Notwithstanding the cessation of Court hearings in Moscow, the United States Trustee has advised the Court that § 341(a) meetings in Central Division bankruptcy cases will continue to be held in the 2nd floor conference room in the U.S. Courthouse in Moscow until further notice. The United States Trustee also anticipates that, likely in January 2018, the meeting location will be changed and those meetings will be held in the County Commissioners conference room located in the Latah County Courthouse, 522 S. Adams St., Basement Room 2B, in Moscow, Idaho. Additional notice will be provided when the details and timing of this change in location of the § 341(a) meetings are finalized.

The proposed hearing dates for Chief Judge Myers in Coeur d'Alene, and the scheduled § 341(a) meeting dates in Moscow, can be found under "Bankruptcy Calendars" at http://idd.uscourts.gov/bankruptcy/Bankruptcy_Calendars.cfm.

District Court: Also effective September 1, 2017, the District Court will conduct hearings on all Central Division cases, including those on Central Violations Bureau (CVB) matters, in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.
