## Job Readiness

Identification Documents: All U.S. employers must complete an <a href="Employment Eligibility Verification"><u>Employment Eligibility Verification Form</u></a> for each individual they hire. Before you begin your job search, we suggest you have in your possession, a state-issued identification card or driver's license, social security card and/or birth certificate to prove that you are eligible to work in the United States. **Master Job Application:** Do you struggle with remembering dates, addresses, skills, supervisor's names and phone numbers? Have a master job application that you can refer to when filling out those long applications so you have all the information you need to fill out any job application completely. **Resume, References and Cover Letter:** Some employers will interview you the day you come in to fill out an application.
