The Court having previously adopted Administrative Rules for the filing of documents by facsimile machine; and


Included in those Administrative Rules previously promulgated by the Court was a provision for the charging of certain fees by the authorized service provider; and


The Court having been advised that, in the interest of ensuring the continued availability of the facsimile service, it is necessary to augment the fee schedule previously approved;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph 9, on page 4 of General Order No. 80, dated May 7, 1992, is hereby AMENDED as follows:

9. The FAX Service selected for this test program is "Court Fax & Copy Service," a division of CP&G, Inc., owned and operated by Mr. C. Pat Wees (voice phone: 208-389-9411, FAX: 208-389-9404). Services described in paragraph 12 will be provided for a cost of ninety-five cents (\$ 0.95) per page, excluding the cover page, with a minimum charge of five dollars (\$ 5.00) per transaction.
