This matter coming before the court upon motion of the Clerk who has informed the court that the number of jurors in the master jury wheel will not be sufficient to cover the needs of the District through the next Presidential election in November 1992;

And the Court being further informed that the cost and administrative burden of supplementing the master jury wheel at this time would cause an undue burden on the office;

And the Court finding, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1861 et. seq., that there is an unanticipated shortage of jurors;

Now therefore, it is Ordered that the Plan for the Random Selection of Grand and Petit Jurors, adopted by General Order 67, on August 24, 1990, be amended as follows:

In Section U, Obligation to Serve and Term of Service, page 12, the term of service for petit jurors is hereby changed from three months to six months until further order of this court.
