GENERAL ORDER NO. 460


On December 30, 2024, President Joseph Biden issued an Executive Order regarding the death of President James Carter, Jr. declaring January 9, 2025, as a National Day of Mourning and providing for the closing of executive departments and agencies of the federal government on that day.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the District of Idaho courthouses in Boise, Pocatello, and Coeur d' Alene will be closed on Thursday, January 9, 2025. The Courts will reopen under normal operating hours on Friday, January 10, 2025.
