GENERAL ORDER NO. 390

On March 27, 2020, the Court issued General Order No. 362. That order addressed various court operations in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Part of that response included physically closing the courthouses for a period of time. To provide *pro se* litigants with a means of filing documents while the courthouses were physically closed, the Court established email filing procedures for *pro se* filers.


