

## REOPENING FEES AND PROCEDURES

Any party wishing to file a pleading or other document in a closed case must submit a motion and order reopening the case, and pay the attendant fee unless otherwise ordered by the court.

There are only limited circumstances where the court may act without reopening a case. See [Fed. R. Bankr. P.](#) 9024. The "attendant fee" is the same as the filing fee for a case under such chapter in effect as of the time of the motion to reopen. See 28 U.S.C. § 1930(b).
